

Thank you for using new Fireborn from Ibstock, discover the advantages:

- Large size means quicker to lay
- Less joints so less mortar to mix & time taken for pointing
- Has a unique colour range
- Highly perforated for lighter weight & easier handling

Before you begin please read these 12 key points

-   Always handle with care - Fireborn block laying is a two handed operation
-   Always store Fireborn on pallets
-   Always keep Fireborn covered when stored
-   Never stack Fireborn pallets
-   Mix Fireborn from several pallets and blend well
-   Always stack with care and store off the ground
-   Use the correct mortar mix and keep a relatively stiff consistency
-   Avoid saturation - do not lay blocks that are wet or stained
-   Lay the face of the block to line, level and plumb with the course below - take care not to damage the face edge when levelling
-   Keep work covered, dry and clean
-   Only cut Fireborn with an industrial, water cooled, diamond tipped saw
-   Clean finished work with care - never use a power jet hose
